Please allow for two days processing time from when you send me this information to receive a notification if you have been selected to for a 2016 WTTC Native Business Scholarship. If selected, you will be asked to register (<http://wttc2016.eventbrite.com/>) and attach your printed registration receipt, hotel receipt and mileage (round trip from your place of business to the Green Bay Radisson) to a completed Inter-Tribal Task Force Scholarship Reimbursement Voucher which will be provided to you at the 2016 WTTC.
