



2018 WISCONSIN TRIBAL TRANSPORTATION CONFERENCE REGISTRATION

The WisDOT Inter-Tribal Task Force presents this year's Wisconsin Tribal Transportation Conference (WTTC).

This is an opportunity for Tribal, local, county, state, federal and transportation construction professionals to come together and increase their knowledge of the governmental and transportation initiatives of the 11 Tribes of Wisconsin and WisDOT.

Sessions include: How to do business with WisDOT, transportation safety, cultural resources and preservation, and federal Indian law and Tribal transportation projects.

- Tribal government representatives who work in planning, roads, natural resources, real estate, cultural resources, historic preservation, economic development and safety.
- Tribal leadership.
- Contractors, construction industry representatives, business owners and consultants.
- Tribal, local, county, state and federal government representatives.
- DBE firms and business owners considering WisDOT contracting.
- Other organizations and agencies that work in the transportation and construction industry.
- WisDOT staff including Tribal liaisons, environmental coordinators, project managers, designers, safety managers or coordinators, transit staff, utility coordinators, local program coordinators and real estate.

CONFERENCE HIGHLIGHTS

Workshops: The conference features four conference tracks: Safety, Cultural/Environmental Resources, Business and Economic Development, and General Transportation topics. The conference also includes important state, federal and Tribal updates, upcoming construction project updates, and networking opportunities.

Business Networking & Vendor Expo: On Tuesday, November 6th, prior to the Opening Ceremony, the Business Speed Network session will be held from 9:30 to 11:30 am. The Business Networking Lunch will be held from 11:30 am to 1:00 pm, and is sponsored by the WisDOT Inter-Tribal Task Force and the American Indian Chamber of Commerce of Wisconsin.

These sessions are designed for anyone interested in business and labor opportunities in the construction industry. Informal networking opportunities with Tribal roads representatives, prime contractors, resource organizations, WisDOT and various other state, Tribal and federal government contract opportunities programs will be available.
