Bad River

A proposed project to improve the intersection at US 2 and Oak Street near the Bad River Casino is moving forward. WisDOT will work with Bad River as the scope of the project is finalized. Efforts made to schedule a meeting with Bad River. The project will include the Native American Hiring Provision language.

In response to a Bad River inquiry, WisDOT confirmed that a driveway access permit was not issued on US 2 because the private land owners need to work with the Tribe/BIA to obtain an easement over tribal trust land.

Red Cliff

A resurfacing project is scheduled in the Town of Russell on Old CTH K from Little Sand Bay Road to Peterson Hill. This project will include the Native American Hiring Provision language.

Lac Courte Oreilles

Work is underway for 2 trail projects that will be managed by LCO under Section 132/202 contracts.

St. Croix

Working with St. Croix on developing pedestrian system in Danbury. Staff continues to work with St. Croix on development of tribal properties in Hertel and Siren. Meeting with St. Croix in February to discuss safety concerns on STH 70.

Ho-Chunk

A resurfacing project is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2019 on STH 54. WisDOT is coordinating with the Tribe for the development of a turn lane into the Blackhawk subdivision as well as an ATV/snowmobile trail. The DOT project will include the Native American Hiring Provision language.
