**Notes from Teleconference:** The meeting began at 10:00 am.

The group reviewed the December meeting notes. Agnes did reach out to Matt and Dennis about dual language signs, and the group discussed the difference between County and Tribal lands, noting a main concern with dual language signs is rescue team response.

The group reviewed the Annual Work Plan:

- Continue to distribute Safety materials
- The Statewide Tribal Safety Plan is ongoing
- Law Enforcement Tracs 10 Training – Sandy suggested emailing Larry directly as Jennifer hasn't responded. The group reviewed the Law Enforcement survey, and Sandy requested a copy and suggested Agnes contact Menomonee to get their participation.
- Keep Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement
- Can remove TSC as the training was done.
- The group suggested Agnes contact Tall Cop regarding training for meth and heroine. Agnes will email him.
- STEM Curriculums. Agnes has contacted LCO, but has not contacted any other Tribal Schools. She will send information to Kim to have her contact other Tribal schools.
- The PSA's are done and waiting for approval to post and share.
- Tribal License Plates – Agnes will contact Larry (Stockbridge, Mole Lake and FCP have no plates).
- New Safety Posters – Suggestions included "Drug Driving: Not a Traditional Way" with Bronson Koenig. Other suggestions for themes included ATV/UTV Safety, Erratic Driving and Pedestrian Safety, and Helmet usage on bikes and ATVs.
- Commercial Vehicle Law Enforcement – Need BOTS input.

The Cultural Sensitivity Training will be done by April 2018.

The next Safety Summit will be held in 2019.
