



Safety & Signage Work Team
Teleconference 2/6/2018

Notes from Teleconference: The meeting began at 10:00 am.

The group discussed the STEM Program. Agnes will review her notes from past research, and put together a report to share with the members.

The group discussed TraCS10 training. Agnes contacted Larry, who provided contact information for Steve Krejci and Dar Schwartz. Agnes needs to identify what types of training the police departments need. Agnes would like to complete this in April.

The group discussed Dual Language. Agnes called Matt to obtain more information, who shared that the signs must follow the MUTCD (Manual Uniform Traffic Control Devices) allowed by FHWA. Dual language signs are not allowed on federal or state highways. Any change would need to be made by Federal Highways.

Kim and Agnes discussed Kelly's email regarding signage on ITTF website, and Agnes will talk with Kim about changes that need to be done on the website.

The group reviewed the Annual Work Plan:

- OTIE – They have one more Tribe to meet with, and are working on a draft report.
- Law Enforcement TraCS10 Training – Agnes would like to have the training done by April so she is recommending to remove this.
- WISLR Mapping System – This is ongoing.
- TSC Meetings – Verify Tribes are being contacted and invited to meetings. Insure Tribes have the state meeting dates.
- Law Enforcement Training – Training will continue in 2018, and Agnes waiting for a BOTS contact person.
- Agnes email Tall Cop regarding training for meth and heroine this morning. Agnes would prefer the training be held in August, and be held at the Holiday Inn in Rothschild.
- Agnes and Kim are reviewing STEM curriculums. The LCO Boys & Girls Club had an offering last summer. Agnes has contacted the LCO school, and she and Kim will review the wording of the request and contact Tribal schools to see what they offer.
- The PSA's are completed and we are waiting for approval to post and share. John shared that the plan is to launch the PSA once the reviews are done.
- Agnes added the 2019 Safety Summit. Discussion was held on who could facilitate the Summit. Sandy suggested contacting Victoria at the regional TTAP office. A location needs to be determined.
- Tribal License Plates – need BOTS input.
- Commercial Vehicle Law Enforcement – need BOTS input.
